

## NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN



Immediate neighbors are your first responders. A plan and coordination between neighbors replace adrenaline chaos, and save lives.

- Use [RYLAN](#) – Ready Your LA Neighborhood – This takes work and patience yet it pays off. You will feel a community spirit that may not have been there before. LA City has experts that will guide you through the process.
- Build a contact list that includes phone numbers and emails for everyone on your block. You'll want to check on all the people in your immediate neighborhood. If the power is out, phones may be working where emails may not.
- Map your block with everyone on it – including pets and kids.
- Stay in touch with each other. Send out periodic emails.
- Do a drill so the entire neighborhood knows what to do and what responsibilities they have.
